

If you think an item could be poisonous, just put the item up and away. Also take the time to read all product labels to make sure you know which of your household products are poisonous for your children. This includes:

- Cosmetics and personal care items (like nail polish remover, jewelry cleaner, mouthwash)
- Medicine and vitamins
- Laundry detergents and cleaning solutions (like bleach, carpet cleaner, furniture polish)
- Alcohol
- Plants
- Car fluids
- Bug and weed killers, fertilizers and plant food
- Lighter fluid, kerosene, and torch fuel
- Batteries
